Music Alive 2017 is open to all school and community ensembles and soloists operating within York Region and its environs, including York Region District School Board, York Catholic District School Board, York Region private schools, community bands, orchestras, choral ensembles and individual musicians.

Goals and Objectives of the Festival

- To provide an opportunity for local musicians, students and educators to present and to share their musical accomplishments and creativity.
- To celebrate the joy of sharing musical experiences.
- To complement and enhance the teaching, learning and growing process.
- To promote reciprocal learning from peers and colleagues.
- To develop and encourage a lifelong interest in music as a social and basic human experience.

Music Alive is intended to highlight and celebrate ensemble music making in York Region, and to connect schools and communities through the medium of music.

- Festival classes will be scheduled between Monday, March 6, 2017 and Friday, May 19, 2017 in a variety of York Region locations.
- School classes will generally be held during the school day.
- Community classes will generally be scheduled in the evening.

The **Music Alive Festival** is subsidized, however entry fees are charged to partially cover organizational expenses, clinicians' fees, and necessary materials. These fees will also ensure the continuation of this festival in future years.
